NEW REGIONAL COLLEGIATE EXPO XPERIENCE TO DEBUT AT BOWLERO NORTH BRUNSWICK LANES AUGUST 2ND-4TH, 2019



The Collegiate Expo Xperience is a great opportunity for high-school bowlers to learn from some of today's top bowling professionals, coaches and industry experts. The Xperience provides practical on-lane instruction with insightful seminars on bowling technology, and navigating the college bowling experience. College coaches from throughout the Eastern Region are expected to be on-hand. Complete details and convenient online registration can be found at **TURBOGRIPS.COM**.

Registration opens February 1, 2019. Enrollment limited to 100 bowlers. High-school student grade level 10-12 or graduated seniors 2019. A minimum entering average of 190+ for guys and 175+ for girls is suggested for best recruiting consideration.

TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. This tournament is open to all youth male and female bowlers who are 20 years of age or less. If your 21st birthday falls before August 5, 2019 you will not be eligible to bowl in this tournament.
- 2. This tournament will have 3 divisions. Scratch Boys, Scratch Girls and Handicap (90% of 210) Youth.
- 3. Entry fees shall be as follows:
 - a. Scratch: Pre-entry = \$80; Walk-in = \$100; Re-entry = \$70
 - b. Handicap: Pre-entry = \$60; Walk-in = \$80; Re-entry = \$50
 - c. **Desperado:** \$35 (3 games)
- 4. All squads will be bowled on a fresh lane oil pattern, 43 feet in length.

5. FORMAT:

<u>OUALIFYING</u>: All Oualifying Squads will be 5 games. One (1) out of every four (4) entries will advance from the Oualifying Squads to the Semi-Final Round.

<u>DESPERADO</u>: A three-game Desperado Squad will be held on Sunday morning. One (1) out of every eight (8) entries will advance from the Desperado squad directly into the Semi-Final Round. NOTE: Bowlers may only participate in the Desperado Squad if they have already bowled in one or more Qualifying Rounds; there are NO direct entries into the Desperado Round.

<u>SEMI-FINALS</u>: Bowlers advancing to the Semi-Final Round will bowl 6 games in the Scratch division, and 4 games in the Handicap division. At that time a cut will be made with one out of 4 entries advancing.

Bowlers making the cut will bowl an additional 3 games in the Scratch division, or an additional 2 games in the Handicap division. The top 5 bowlers in each division will advance to the Finals.

<u>FINALS</u>: The top 5 bowlers from each division will compete in a stepladder format to determine the Champion. Matches will be one game, and seeding for the top 5 will be determined based on pinfall total from the Semi-Final Round (including handicap in the Handicap division).

- 6. AVERAGES: Bowlers will use their Highest Final league average from the 2018-2019 of 21 games or more. If none, then bowlers will use their 2017-2018 USBC league average of 21 games or more. Bowlers with a 210 average or higher must bowl in the Scratch division.
- 7. Bowlers must declare their division choice at registration.
- 8. DRESS CODE: All bowlers must wear shirts with collars and sleeves. Bowlers are not permitted to wear hats or other headgear, ripped or torn clothing, or basketball shorts.
- 9. No clothing with offensive language or graphics, nor any apparel which the tournament director feels is inappropriate. Smoking is not permitted by bowlers before, during or after the tournament. Proper behavior is expected at all times. Only those bowlers who are still in competition and tournament officials will be permitted in the settee area.
- 10. Scholarships will be awarded based on the final standings of the tournament, with a minimum of one scholarship will being awarded for every four participants. The first place scholarship to be awarded in each division is as follows: \$2000 scholarship for Scratch Division Boy; \$2000 scholarship for Scratch Division Girl; \$1000 scholarship for Handicap Division Youth. All first place payouts are guaranteed. Additional spots will be paid as stated above. All scholarships will be submitted into the bowlers USBC SMART account.
- 11. All rules specifically not covered will be governed by the tournament committee and will use the USBC rule book as a guide. The tournament committee reserves all rights regarding all rules and the operation of the tournament.
